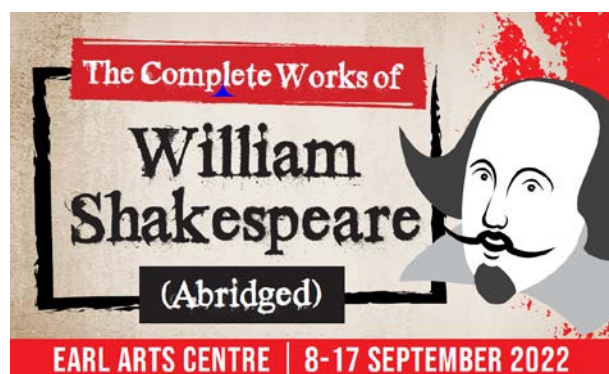
APRIL PRODUCTION – “BUMS ON SEATS”
